WHY EQUINE THERAPY?: AUTISM

While therapeutic riding has numerous benefits for individuals facing a wide variety of disabilities, equine therapy uniquely helps individuals with autism by enhancing core impairments for people with autism. which is a common symptom of autism spectrum disorder (American Psychiatric Association, 2013). Additionally, therapeutic riding has beneficial effects on behavioral skills (Lentini & Knox, 2015), social communication (Wiese et al., 2016), emotional regulation (Lentini & Knox, 2015), and cognitive functioning (McDaniel & Wood, 2017). Each of these are core impairments of autism spectrum disorder. Therapeutic riding uniquely provides an environment that can address the physical, emotional, behavioral, and cognitive impairments of autism spectrum disorder—all through the help of a therapeutic riding companion.


